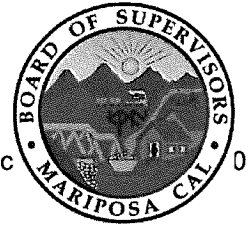

RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2015-90

TO: The Board of Supervisors

RE: Alliance for Community Transformations Heritage House Agreement

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve an Agreement with Alliance for Community Transformations in an Amount not to exceed \$20,000 to provide recovery support services at the Mariposa Heritage House for Substance Abuse Clients Referred by Mariposa County Behavioral Health, and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Agreement.

By June 30, 2015, the Alliance agrees to increase the following services to clients of the Drug Court Program and other Community clients through the Mariposa Heritage House Program:

- Increased Alcohol and Other Drugs (AOD) peer counseling
- Increased jobs skills building groups and classes (resume building, soft skills, interview skills, etc.)
- Increased self-care and wellness groups, helping individuals to stay clean and sober (nutrition, yoga, tobacco prevention, etc.)
- Provide transportation to clients to and from appointments and services
- The Alliance agrees to provide a final report to the County no later than July 31, 2015. Report will include numbers of clients served, numbers of activities/sessions/groups/etc.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

This is a new Agreement to expand services at the Mariposa Heritage House. The Board approved another Agreement with Alliance to provide expanded services for the Drug Court Grant on June 17, 2014 by Resolution 2014-281.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this Agreement is not approved, the County will not have the additional services available through the Heritage House.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This Agreement will be paid with Drug Court Grant funds. The budget for line 01-0403-623.04-18 is sufficient to cover the additional expenditures. There is no impact to the County General Fund.
