## **RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2015-217**

TO: The Board of Supervisors

RE: Second Amendment to a Contract with ARAMARK for Uniform Laundry Services and Janitorial Supplies

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### **RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

Approve Second Amendment to a Contract for Services with ARAMARK to Provide Uniform Laundry Service and Janitorial Supplies by Increasing Compensation in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$2,400 for Total Compensation of \$30,382.24 per year; and Authorize the Public Works Director to Sign the Second Amendment.

The contract with ARAMARK was due to expire on May 3, 2015, and recently was extended through June 30. While this action provided the needed contract length, projections show that the annual cap on the contract will have been reached by that time. This requested action increases the funding amount to the level needed to support the paying of invoices for services rendered in June.

### **BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:**

On October 25, 2011, Resolution 11-527 authorized Public Works to award the contract for uniform laundry services and janitorial supplies to ARAMARK in the not to exceed amount of \$83,946.72 (\$27,982.24 per year) for a term of three years.

On March 3, 2015, Resolution 15-97 approved the First Amendment to the Contract extending the term to June 30, 2018.

### **ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:**

Do not approve the Second Amendment. Negative action would result in the County not having the resources to release payment for outstanding invoices for charges accumulated in the month of June.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

**Sufficient funds are available in budgets to cover costs through FY 14/15.**

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES**

**THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES** is made and entered into this 5<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2015, by and between the County of Mariposa, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "County" and ARAMARK, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

**WHEREAS**, the County and Contractor have heretofore entered into a Contract dated June 5, 2012 wherein Contractor agreed to provide uniform laundry service and janitorial supplies for County facilities and;

**WHEREAS**, County and Contractor have entered into the first amendment of said Contract to extend the Contract thirty (30) days, to June 30, 2015, in an effort to coordinate the beginning of the next uniform laundry service and janitorial supplies contract with the beginning of a new fiscal year; and to extend the contact for an additional three (3) years beginning July 1, 2015 in an attempt to maintain the County's business, Contractor agrees to keep prices as they currently are.

**WHEREAS**, County and Contractor desire to increase the compensation for said Contract in the not to exceed amount of \$2,400 for total compensation of \$30,382.24 per year.


**NOW THEREFORE**, the parties hereto in consideration of the mutual covenants herein recited, hereby agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 4.01 "COMPENSATION" is hereby amended to increase the compensation in the not to exceed amount of \$2,400 for total compensation of \$30,382.24 per year.

Except as herein amended, the Contract dated June 5, 2012, together with the First Amendment dated March 3, 2015 extending the term of the Contact to June 30, 2015 in an effort to coordinate the beginning of the next uniform laundry service and janitorial supplies contract and further extending the Contract for an additional three years beginning July 1, 2015 in an attempt to maintain the County's business, shall remain in full force and effect.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, the parties have caused this Amendment to be executed on the date first above written.


