## **RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2015-96**

RE: 2015-2017 Justice Assistance Grant

### **RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

Adopt a resolution to participate in the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Federal Grant program, also known as, the Drug Task Force and Project School Climate, effective March 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017; and authorize the Chief Probation Officer to sign the grant application and agreement, including any amendments, modifications or extensions thereof, with the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) for annual funding based on Federal allocations to the State of California (Subject to approval as to form by County Counsel.).

On February 12, 2015, BSCC approved the grant application submitted by Mariposa County Probation Department.

A budget action increasing revenue and appropriations will be brought back to the Board for approval, once the grant money has been awarded and received.

The grant application has been approved for funding in the amount of \$202,360.00 for the first year, March 1, 2015, through December 31, 2015. The Probation Department will have to reapply for the grant funds each year, however, BSCC plans to fund the grant program at the same amount for each consecutive year of the grant period, contingent on Federal allocations to the State in years two and three.

### **BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:**

On December 2, 2014, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 2014-619, authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to sign the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Federal Grant application.

### **ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:**

If this request is not granted, the County will not be able to accept the grant award from the Board of State and Community Corrections and the Drug Task Force and Project School Climate programs will not be funded.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**


**A budget action increasing revenue and appropriations will be brought back to the Board for approval once the grant money has been awarded and received. The Justice Assistance Grant is fully funded with State and Federal Grant Funds.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors desires to participate in the Drug Task Force and Project School Climate Programs supported by the Federal Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as the BSCC), for the grant period dated March 1, 2015 to December 31, 2017.



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mariposa County Probation Department, as the implementing agency, and the Mariposa County Sheriff's Department and Mariposa County District Attorney's Office , as the partnering entities, agree to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the Federal Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC.
