RE: Approve Plans and Specifications for Triangle Road Reconstruction

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve Plans and Specifications for Triangle Road Reconstruction, (Project No. 07-12 (13)) for 1.56 Miles from Post Mile Marker 20.06 To Post Mile Marker 21.62; Authorize the Public Works Director to Solicit Bid Proposals and Award the Bid to the Lowest Responsible Bidder.

Agreement will come back to the Board for review and approval.

The work consists of reconstructing 1.56 miles of Triangle Road to the typical sections and details contained in these specifications. This will include minor widening, grind out work, and two lifts of asphalt concrete compacted structural section. The design leveling course is two inches (2") thick, twenty two feet (22') wide, and the surface course is two and one half (2.5") thick, twenty two feet (22') wide. Also included are driveway paved tie-ins and wing outs, temporary pavement markers, shoulder backing and application of painted traffic stripes.

Due to the possibility of inclement weather, the specifications for this project include a provision to delay commencement of the project up to 180 days, which will allow the option defer the start of construction to Spring 2016.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board of Supervisors adopted the 2014 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP), LTC-2013-15 on December 10, 2013. On May 28, 2015 the California Transportation Commission (CTC) allocated funding for this project, with the stipulation that the project be awarded within six months.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Board approval is necessary to proceed with project award and construction. The Board could choose to direct Public Works to delay award and request an extension of the funds from Caltrans, but there is no guarantee this extension would be granted.
