

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 615

2 AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 2.68.270
3 ENTITLED "DISTRIBUTION OF COUNTY PAYROLL WARRANTS"
4 TO THE MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE, PURSUANT TO
5 GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 28003 and 53910

6 WHEREAS, the distribution of payroll warrants is
7 at the present time governed by Government Code Section
8 28001, and

9 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of
10 Mariposa deems it to be in the best interest of the County to
11 distribute County payroll warrants pursuant to Government Code
12 Sections 28003 and 53910, in place and stead of Government Code
13 Section 28001.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa
15 County, a political subdivision of the State of California, does
16 ordain as follows:

17 SECTION I: Section 2.68.270 is hereby added to the Mariposa
18 County Code to read as follows:

19 "Section 2.68.270 Distribution of County payroll
20 warrants. A. All salary and payroll warrants shall be
21 dated, and distributed by the Auditor, on the last regular
22 working day of each month, beginning the last regular
23 working day of the month wherein this Ordinance becomes
24 effective.

25 B. It shall be the responsibility of each Department
26 Head or a representative selected by each Department Head,
27 to pick-up from the Auditor's office, the warrants for
28 salary payroll of each employee and officer between 4:30
and 5:00 p.m. on the last regular working day of each month.

For those Department Heads, employees and officers whose departments are closed on the last regular working day, or are located outside the township of Mariposa, it shall be the responsibility of the Auditor to place said warrants in the mail, so that said warrants are received on the last working day of each month.

C. Post-dated warrants shall not be issued; the drafting and mailing of warrants as described in "B" above, shall not be considered post-dated warrants for the purposes of this Paragraph."

SECTION II: This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of final passage pursuant to Government Code Section 25123. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage, this ordinance shall be published once in the Mariposa Gazette, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Mariposa, with the names of the members voting for and against it.
