

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE No. 588

2 AN URGENCY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
3 THE POSITION OF INTERIM PURCHASING AGENT
4 AS A TEMPORARY POSITION

5 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 584 was adopted to bring the opera-
6 tions of Mariposa County into conformity with the laws of the
7 State of California regarding procedures for purchasing; and

8 WHEREAS, it being necessary for the orderly operation of
9 government in Mariposa County to establish some means of purchas-
10 ing necessary supplies and equipment while more permanent proce-
11 dures are devised;

12 NOW THEREFORE the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County
13 does ordain as follows:

14 SECTION I: Section 3.08.031 is hereby added to the Mariposa
15 County Code to read in its entirety as follows:

16 "3.08.031 Temporary interim purchasing agent. Until
17 such time as a permanent purchasing agent or other method or
18 procedure is established by county ordinance for purchasing
19 supplies and equipment other than by bidding procedures, the
20 chairman of the board of supervisors shall act as temporary
21 interim purchasing agent for Mariposa County, together with
22 such assistants as shall be authorized, and said interim
23 purchasing agent shall have authority over purchases of
24 supplies and equipment, and such other purchasing as may be
25 required by state law and county code, up to three thousand
26 dollars (\$3,000.00) in amount."

27 SECTION II: This ordinance shall become effective immedi-
28 ately upon passage by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Super-
visors pursuant to Government Code Section 25123. The facts con-

stituting the urgency are as follows:

Purchases of supplies and equipment are essential to the orderly provision of all governmental services. The immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety require that such items be available to government agencies without the delay inherent in the development of permanent and complex purchasing and bidding procedures.




