

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 92-179

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SB 1573 (THOMPSON)  
RELATING TO COMMUNITY CARE FACILITIES

WHEREAS, SB 1573 (Thompson) is a reasonable attempt to address the growing problems caused by the rapidly increasing demands for locating and operating community care facilities; and

WHEREAS, such pressing requirements to accommodate these significant needs have created substantial fiscal and programmatic burdens on the ability of small counties to provide and maintain their small school systems and to serve rural residents with an adequate level of essential local services; and

WHEREAS, SB 1573 priority issues include, but are not limited to, overconcentration, the "300 foot rule", placement notification, payment of reasonable costs, etc.; and

WHEREAS, SB 1573 is a reasonable and balanced effort to further current state policy demands in the Health and Safety Code and maintain proper controls and safeguards by more effectively allocating public resources consistent with the highest and best public good; and

WHEREAS, the Senate Committee on Health and Human Services is conducting a Hearing in regard to SB 1573 on Wednesday, April 8, 1992.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that SB 1573 is supported and urges the Committee on Health and Human Services to support it.




