RESOLUTION NO. 92-559

**A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING
THE CONSERVATORSHIP/PUBLIC GUARDIAN
FUNCTIONS TO VETERANS SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Mariposa County District Attorney has requested in the past that the Conservatorship and Public Guardian functions be transferred from the District Attorney's office, and

WHEREAS, based upon staffing difficulties and lack of sufficient office space in the District Attorney's office and further based upon budgetary considerations for the 1992/93 fiscal year, there is a need to transfer the Conservatorship and Public Guardian functions from the District Attorney's office;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION I: Effective October 6, 1992, the Conservatorship and Public Guardian functions shall be transferred from the District Attorney's office to the Veterans Services office.

SECTION II: Be it further resolved that County Counsel is directed to review previous actions of the Board of Supervisors relative to the Conservatorship and Public Guardian functions and prepare any amendments necessary to existing Resolutions and/or Ordinances.


