

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 91-141

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING LOCATION OF THE NEXT UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA CAMPUS IN MERCED COUNTY

WHEREAS, Mariposa County recognizes surging enrollments at the University of California (UC) make a tenth UC campus a distinct possibility; and,

WHEREAS, the residents of this area have shown enthusiastic support for the UC expansion in Merced County; and,

WHEREAS, Merced and Mariposa Counties, with their high-growth potential and central location in the State; coupled with Merced's availability of land, make the Merced UC site a prime location; and,

WHEREAS, UC expansion in Merced County would provide an important and tremendous economic boost to this area; and,

WHEREAS, the areas environment is conducive to University life with recreational facilities, natural resources, uncongested traffic circulation and transportation and cultural resources; and,

WHEREAS, the impact of this location for a UC campus would be positive and would greatly enhance our local educational system, as well as create critically needed employment opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, strongly supports the concept of UC expansion and urges the University of California to locate their tenth campus in Merced County.
