RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION: (Policy Item: Yes X No     )  
Recommend resolution authorizing Health Officer to proceed with a program of education, purchase, and administration of vaccine against Hepatitis B for First Responders involved with volunteer fire departments and Sheriff's Office and appropriation of \$8,400 for this purpose.

The Health Officer presented this item to the Board on March 5th and was directed to come back with more specific information, including costs. Four sources of vaccine were investigated and costs compared. The two best costs were offered by a local pharmacist and by the Smith, Klein, French salesman: \$130.00 per individual.

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BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

Some of the Supervisors have had requests from volunteer firefighters to investigate this issue. The EMCC discussed it and recommended that the Board consider offering vaccination. The Board took action requesting more information on March 5th of this year.

1. Medical First Responders should be urged to seek vaccination at their own costs.
2. Medical First Responders should not be urged to seek vaccination (not recommended).

However, the SKF salesman has also offered to pay the Health Officer \$500.00 each for two talks of an educational nature on Hepatitis B, and to donate \$350.00 for television or similar appliance which could be raffled off to further generate funds. For the estimated 25 recipients in the Sheriff's Department and 50 recipients in the volunteer fire departments, the cost would be \$9,750. If we take the SKF offer, their donations would reduce the total price to \$8,400.
