MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 91-238

NEW RANGER STATION, GROVELAND, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the Groveland Ranger district was created in 1905 with over 200,000 acres in the southern portion of the Stanislaus National Forest; and

WHEREAS, in 1974 the Groveland Ranger Station was relocated to the historic Groveland Hotel, a two-story building with main walls three feet thick, which served the area for over 120 years and was one of the first buildings erected in the original town of Groveland; and

WHEREAS, after 10 years at the Groveland Hotel the ranger station moved back to near the original location. Several new buildings were erected on this site, and in 1990 construction for the new ranger station was begun on the original 1908 site; and

WHEREAS, the new station was occupied in early April, 1991, with the front office being decorated with some of the original oak furniture out of the 1908 ranger station, and the original "Groveland Ranger Station" sign being restored; and

WHEREAS, an Open House at the new ranger station will be held July 21 and 22, 1991, in conjunction with the National Forest Centennial Open House celebrating the Forest Service's first 100 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, does hereby recognize and compliment the community of Groveland on the new ranger station facilities, and urges the participation of the citizens of Mariposa County in attending the forthcoming Open House.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors this 11 day of June, 1991, by unanimous vote.
