MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 91-359

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING EDNA HOTCHKIN FOR HER SERVICE
ON THE MARIPOSA COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION
REPRESENTING DISTRICT I

WHEREAS, Edna Hotchkin served on the Planning Commission from June 19, 1984 to July 27, 1991 and is presently the longest serving member on the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Edna was a highly dedicated and motivated Commissioner and made a special effort to attend workshops and seminars to learn more about Planning; and

WHEREAS, Edna was also an active member of a variety of advisory committees including; Fish Camp Community Planning Advisory Committee, Wawona Town Planning Advisory Committee, Yosemite West Task Force, Subdivision Committee; and

WHEREAS, Edna was involved in and contributed greatly to the following significant projects which have been considered by the Commission and Board of Supervisors:

- Adoption of the County's First Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance (Title 17)
- Golden Bell Mining Company Mining Permit
- Mariposa Town Planning Area Specific Plan Update Review; and
- Blue Moon Mine Exploration Permit
- Development of commercial and industrial land use policies for inclusion into the General Plan
- Review of State Fire Safe Standards
- Development of design review and historical design review standards for the communities of Coulterville and Mariposa
- Establishment of scenic highway standards leading to the designation of Highway 140 as a State Scenic Highway
- Mariposa County General Plan Housing Element; and

WHEREAS, Edna was involved in and contributed greatly to major projects in District I which were considered by the Commission and the Board including; the adoption of the Wawona Town Planning Area Specific Plan and the Tenaya Lodge Hotel Project in Fish Camp.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that Edna Hotchkin be commended for her service as a member of the Planning Commission and her contribution to the betterment of Mariposa County.
