3 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION ON THE PROPOSED  
4 MARIPOSA COUNTY VEHICLE MAINTENANCE SHOP.

5 WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act and  
6 Mariposa County Resolution No. 86-151 require that environmental  
7 review be performed on projects; and,

8 WHEREAS, Mariposa County desires to relocate the  
9 existing Vehicle Maintenance Shop from its present location  
10 adjacent to professional offices and residences in the town of  
11 Mariposa, to a site adjoining the existing County Road yard; and,

12 WHEREAS, an Initial Study has been prepared,  
13 identifying mitigation measures which adequately address all  
14 identified environmental effects, a public review period  
15 provided, and public comments received in accordance with State  
16 law and Mariposa County's Environmental Review Policies and  
17 Procedures.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of  
19 Supervisors hereby incorporates all mitigation measures listed in  
20 the initial study into the project design and further determines  
21 that the project will not have a significant effect on the  
22 environment. A Negative Declaration is hereby adopted.



(Pursuant to California Administrative Code, Section 15070)


