

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 87-491

A RESOLUTION REGARDING PENALTY ASSESSMENTS
BY JUSTICE COURTS AND ESTABLISHMENT
OF ACCOUNTS REGARDING PENALTY ASSESSMENTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARIPOSA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of California, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors hereby determines that enactment of the provisions of Sections 76000 and 76009 of the California Government Code are necessary to provide an adequate fingerprint identification system in the County, and the Board of Supervisors hereby establishes in the County Treasury a County Automated Fingerprint Identification Fund to be known as "County Automated Fingerprint Identification Fund, Fund No. 128."

2. The Justice Court of the County of Mariposa shall, beginning January 1, 1988, impose a penalty assessment of fifty cents (.50 cents) for every Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or fraction thereof for every fine, penalty, or forfeiture imposed and collected by the Justice Court for criminal offenses, including all offenses involving a violation of the Vehicle Code or any local ordinance adopted pursuant to the Vehicle Code except offenses relating to parking or registration or offenses by pedestrians or bicyclists. The penalty assessments imposed herein shall be used exclusively for an automated fingerprinted identification program.

3. The County of Mariposa hereby establishes an emergency medical services fund pursuant to California Penal Code Section 1465, and California Health and Safety Code Section 1797.98(a) to be known as "Mariposa County Emergency Medical Services Fund, Fund No. 134."

4. The Justice Court of the County of Mariposa shall, beginning January 1, 1988, impose a One Dollar (\$1.00) penalty assessment for every Ten Dollars (\$10.00) fine or fraction thereof in addition to the assessments levied pursuant to Section 1464 of the California Penal Code. The penalty assessments imposed herein shall be used exclusively for purposes of emergency medical services as outlined in Section 1797.98(a) of the California Health and Safety Code.


