

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 87-12
REGARDING PENALTY ASSESSMENTS, JUSTICE COURT

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, as follows:

A. Pursuant to Chapter 40508.5 of the California Vehicle Code and Section 853.7(a) of the California Penal Code, the Justice Court of the County of Mariposa shall impose a Seven Dollar (\$7.00) penalty assessment, in addition to other fees, and whether or not a fine is imposed, upon conviction of violation of a written promise to appear. Bail schedules shall be increased to reflect the assessment, and, if the bail is returned, the amount of the assessment shall also be returned. The penalty assessments imposed herein shall be used exclusively for an automated county warrant system.

B. Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 23196, any person convicted of a driving under the influence offense in County shall pay an alcohol abuse education and prevention penalty assessment in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). Such penalty is payable even if probation is granted. The amount may be reduced in the court's discretion depending upon ability of the defendant to pay.

C. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 11802, all monies deposited in the Alcohol Abuse Education and Prevention Fund pursuant to Section 1463.25 of the California Penal Code are hereby allocated by the administrator of that fund to alcohol abuse education and prevention programs in the schools and communities located in County.

D. Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 11372.7, any person who is convicted of a drug-related violation shall pay a drug program fee in an amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each separate offense. This drug program fee shall be added to and shall increase the total fine which shall be in addition to any other penalty prescribed by law. The drug program fee may be reduced in the court's discretion depending upon the ability of the defendant to pay. The amounts deposited in the drug program fund shall be allocated by the fund administrator of the County's drug program to drug abuse programs in the schools and the communities of County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the penalty assessments described herein shall become effective immediately upon passage of this Resolution.
