NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Project: County Code Amendment No. 2017-169
Proponent: County of Mariposa
Amendment Area: Countywide; Amendment to Chapter 2.90 of Title 2, Mariposa County Code

Project Description: Amendments to Chapter 2.90 (Historic Sites and Records Preservation Commission) of Title 2 of Mariposa County Code; Administration and Personnel. The amendments update and clarify county code text governing the functioning of the Historic Sites and Records Preservation Commission. In addition to minor changes in code text, the amendments:

- 1) update and change the list of organizations that can be represented on the commission and make such representation a recommendation not a requirement;
- 2) remove alternate membership categories;
- 3) change unlimited terms of office to staggered three (3) year terms of office;
- 4) establish a maximum number of a member's excused absences for grounds for removal action by the Board of Supervisors;
- 5) clarify when officers are to be elected;
- 6) allow published agendas to be emailed in lieu of mailing;
- 7) amend the required time the commission has to make a referral on a project; and
- 8) remove reference to the building department as supporting staff to the commission.

Please be advised that any concerns or issues related to this code amendment project must be raised during the public review process described in this notice, if those issues are to be used for the basis of a future court challenge. If you challenge the action of the Board of Supervisors to approve or deny County Code Amendment No. 2017-169 in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the public hearing.

A staff report will be available for review at the Planning Department approximately 7 days prior to the scheduled public hearing date.

Written comments may be made and submitted at any time during the public review period up to, and including, the public portion of the public hearing time. Letters or written comments submitted after the public input time of the public hearing will become part of the file documents, but will not become part of the record unless the public input time is reopened.
