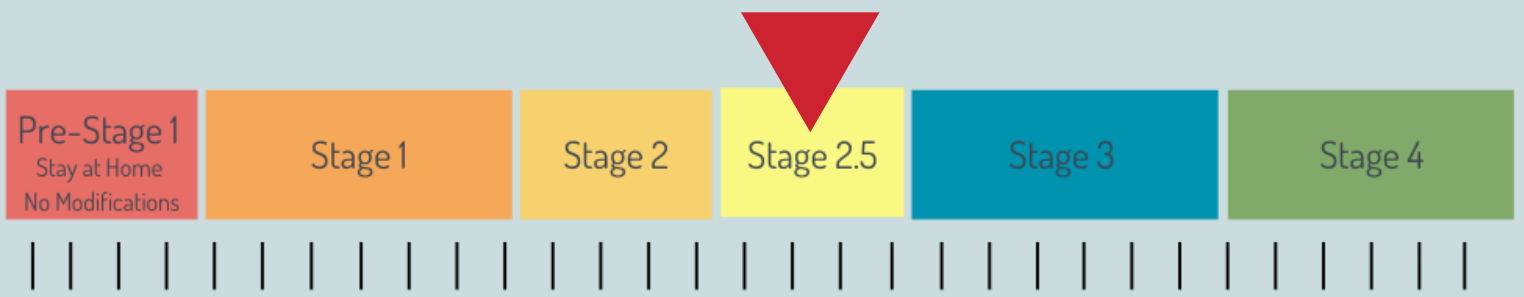


Mariposa County Reopening Sliding Scale

STAGE 2.5

Goal: Reopen More Low-Risk Businesses



Key indicators to move to and remain in Stage 2.5:

- Hospitalization and ICU trends stable.
- Hospital surge capacity to meet demand.
- Sufficient PPE supply to meet demand.
- Sufficient testing capacity to meet demand.
- Contact tracing capacity statewide.

Remember, to stay in Stage 2.5, and move forward, we must stay vigilant and avoid the spread of COVID-19 in Mariposa County.

The stages are a sliding scale that can move both forward and backward.

Open Businesses:

- Essential businesses
- Retail (relaxed modifications)
- Logistics & Manufacturing
- Dine-in restaurants
- Schools and childcare facilities can reopen
- Personal services, limited to: car washes, pet grooming, tanning
- Malls and swap meets

Appropriate Activities:

- Outdoor recreation with proper social distancing. Please check with the agency responsible for these places regarding access.
- Essential travel
- Office-based businesses (Teleworking encouraged)
- Outdoor museums

There is a PCR testing site within Mariposa County run by OptumServe with NO COST to individuals.
