RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve the assignment of county vehicles and take-home vehicles. Chapter 2.76 of the County Code requires that the Board of Supervisors annually assign county vehicles as well as authorize which vehicles are allowed to be take-home vehicles. There have been no substantive changes to the previous list that the Board of Supervisors approved on September 21, 2010. Minor changes include the addition/deletion of county vehicles, and changes in personnel. It should be noted that the vehicle assigned to the Planning department is considered a "pool" vehicle which may be used by other county departments.

Attached is a list of assigned county vehicles indicating which vehicles are take-home and the employee that takes the vehicle home. There are no recommended changes to the current status of take-home vehicles.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS

The Board adopted Resolution 10-448 approving the assignment of county vehicles and which vehicles are take-home vehicles.



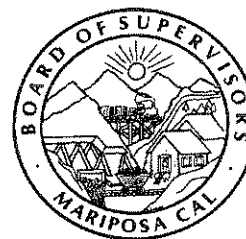

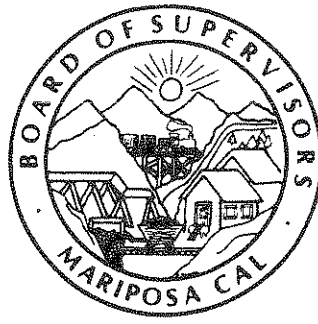

Approve the Assignment of County Vehicles and Take-Home Vehicles
BOARD ACTION: Rick Benson initiated discussion. Supervisor Cann noted that the PWD-Facility Maintenance Manager only takes a vehicle home when it is felt that it might be needed versus on a regular basis, and he suggested that the Public Works Director might want to look at the assignment of all of the vehicles in the Department to see if that type of assignment would work to save County costs. Supervisor Allen noted that the PWD-Fleet Superintendent has a vehicle that is unmarked and he feels that it should have the County insignia, and he questioned the necessity of assignment of this vehicle on the take home list given the information provided by the Fleet Superintendent during the final budget hearings that there is minimal call out.
- Input from the public was provided by the following:
- Ruth Catalan stated she does not see any accountability; i.e., logging of mileage for the usage of the vehicles, and she questioned the necessity of taking vehicles home, other than for fire and law enforcement – she feels that is like having an extra perk.
- Further discussion was held. Peter Rei advised that he will review the issues raised for Public Works. Rick Benson responded to the issue raised relative to the mileage log and tracking the fueling of vehicles. (M)Cann, (S)Stetson, Res. 11-437a was adopted approving the assignment of County vehicles and take-home vehicles with a modification that the PWD-Fleet Superintendent's assignment of take-home vehicle is only authorized when there is some apparent reason that justifies it versus on a regular basis effective November 1, 2011; and noting that the department heads can come back at any time to ask for a change/Ayes: Stetson, Bibby, Cann, Allen; Excused: Turpin.

Subject: Take Home Vehicle Justification

Detailed below is the justification for certain positions within county departments being allowed to take county vehicles home.

District Attorney

The take home vehicle is assigned to the District Attorney Investigator who is a sworn law enforcement officer and the vehicle is equipped with safety equipment (emergency lights, sirens, radio, and firearms). This position is subject to being asked to respond to any emergency by either the District Attorney or when requested by other law enforcement agencies. In the event of an officer involved shooting it is necessary for the District Attorney Investigator position to respond immediately to the scene of the incident as a member of the investigation team. Additionally, this position also responds to emergency incidents involving drug labs, murders, and other high profile cases.

Fire

Both the Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief positions are on call twenty-four hours a day, seven-days a week to respond to emergencies. The Volunteer Division Chiefs and Battalion Chiefs are not paid county employees, but may have coverage for emergency responses on weekdays, weekends, holidays, and evenings depending on the response schedule determined by the Fire Chief. Two of the Volunteer Division Chief positions are assigned to various areas in the County because of their residences – Fish Camp, Wawona, & Yosemite West; and Greeley Hill, Coulterville, and Don Pedro. The third Volunteer Division Chief has responsibility for all fire investigations. The Volunteer Battalion Chief only takes the vehicle home when on duty.

Human Services

There are seven (7) vehicles in the Department that are take home vehicles when the employee is “on call” for incidents that involve Child Protective and Adult Protective Services. Child Welfare and Adult Services Social Workers are required and must be available to respond to incidences after hours as warranted by program regulations. These are rotating shifts of “on call” duty and will vary from week to week between specific employees.

Probation

The Chief Probation Officer takes a vehicle home for emergency responses to the juvenile hall after normal work hours, weekends, and holidays. Other positions within the department may on occasion take a vehicle home when assigned as "on call."

Public Works

The Facilities Maintenance Manager position is assigned a take home vehicle for responding to any county facility, park, or sewer facility emergency or crisis that occurs, whether during normal work hours or after hours, weekends, or holidays. The vehicle assigned to this position is equipped with maintenance equipment. The current employee in this position does not take the vehicle home on a daily basis, only during foul weather and during emergency situations.

The Fleet Superintendent position is assigned a take home vehicle for responding to emergency repairs on county vehicles including fire equipment after normal work hours, weekends, and holidays. This position also has the authority to authorize towing and to assign a replacement vehicle for one that is out of service. The vehicle assigned to this position is outfitted with vehicle repair equipment.

The Road Superintendent is assigned a take home vehicle and is available to attend all varieties of road emergencies and/or road problems that may occur after normal work hours and during weekends and holidays. This position receives calls concerning road conditions and many of these calls necessitate travel to the site to ascertain a remedy and notify the appropriate personnel. The vehicle assigned to this position is outfitted with repair and maintenance equipment.

The Maintenance Construction Supervisor positions are assigned take home vehicles that are equipped with snow removal capabilities, chain saws, and other necessary repair/maintenance equipment. These positions are on called upon for snow removal, road sign issues, and removing downed trees and large dead animals from county maintained roadways after normal work hours, weekends, and holidays. Some of these positions have residences in Jerserydale, Greeley Hill, and Catheys Valley which allow for timely responses outside of the Mariposa town area. The current Maintenance Construction Supervisor – Sign Shop employee resides out-of-county and does not take the vehicle home.

Sheriff

The Sheriff, Undersheriff, Captain, Sergeant, Detective, and Deputy Sheriff positions are all assigned take home vehicles. These positions are on call twenty-four hours a day, seven-days a week for emergency responses. Having a marked Sheriff's car in the community also gives the constituents a sense of security and may ward off potential criminal acts. A Deputy Sheriff position is not allowed to take a vehicle home if they have not yet completed the required training or live out of county.
