RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended that your Board (1) approve a Contract for Services with Infant/Child Enrichment Services (ICES); and (2) authorize your Chairman to sign the contract.

BACKGROUND

The Department of Human Services, Social Services, Welfare to Work unit, contracts with ICES for child care services for parents transitioning from Welfare to Work. Your Board entered into an agreement with ICES in 1998/1999 (Resolution 98-281) and has continued to renew for contract services annually since that time.

CURRENT SITUATION

The Department contracts with ICES for Stage One Child Care Services for CalWORKs/TANF recipients participating in an approved employment activity such as, but not limited to: employment, job search, and attending training or school. Stage One child care begins upon entry of a person into the CalWORKs assistance program, while Stage Two may begin when the county determines stability or when a recipient is transitioning off aid. This service continues to be of importance to assist people to transition from Welfare to Work. During fiscal year 2009/2010, approximately 109 families with 163 children received child care services

FINANCIAL

The contract amount for fiscal year is \$83,321. The dollars pay for the cost of child care. In addition 29% is set aside for ICES staff that directly works to coordinate this service for the clients and general administrative support. This program component is fully funded by state and federal funds. There is no impact to the County's General Fund.
