

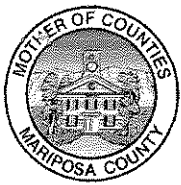

RE: Mental Health Contract for Children and Adolescents placed out of county

**Recommendation:**

It is respectfully recommended that your Board: (1) approve continuing a contract for residential inpatient services with County Villa Health Services; and (2) authorize your Chairman to sign the contract.

**Background:**

Mariposa County does not operate in-patient residential facilities and therefore contracts for such services. Country Villa Health Services is a locked residential facility that is used to house clients who need a higher level of care than is provided at a board and care or a private residence.

Clients referred to this facility would include LPS conservatives who are severely mentally ill and not able to maintain an appropriate level of behavior or take care of providing daily food, shelter or clothing for themselves without assistance and close supervision. This facility is used until such time as clients are stabilized and are able to be moved to a lower level of care.

**Financial:**

The rate for this service is \$171.53 per patient per day. This contract will continue to be paid within the Mental Health budget unit 0402.

There is no impact to general fund dollars.
