RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve a Loan Agreement with the Area 12 Agency on Aging to loan up to \$47,690 to assist with their cash needs in funding their operation until the State Budget is adopted and authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign the loan agreement. The Area 12 Agency on Aging is a joint powers agency that manages the federally funded senior programs in Amador, Calaveras, Mariposa, and Tuolumne Counties. Until the State Budget is adopted the Agency will not receive the funding necessary to continue with their operation. The Agency is requesting a loan from Amador, Calaveras, Mariposa, and Tuolumne Counties based upon the allocation of services provided by the Agency to the Counties. Once the State Budget is adopted and the Agency begins to receive their federal funding they will reimburse each of the Counties.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board adopted Resolution 09-316 on June 23, 2009, approving a loan agreement with the Area 12 Agency on Aging to loan \$68,990. The State Budget was approved in sufficient time and the loan was not required.

The Board adopted Resolution 08-432 on September 8, 2008, approving a loan agreement with the Area 12 Agency on Aging to loan \$16,893. The loan was paid back in full by November 2008.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve the loan agreement with the Area 12 Agency on Aging. The Agency will most likely have insufficient funds to continue with their operation if the State is delinquent in adopting the State Budget. If the Agency had to close its operation it may jeopardize the County receiving its federal funds as the funding must pass through a separate entity and cannot come directly to the County.
