

Recommendation

It is respectfully requested that your Board: (1) approve continuing a Behavioral Health contract for residential alcohol and drug treatment services with Comprehensive Addiction Programs, Inc., and (2) authorize your Chairman to sign the contract.

Background/Current Situation

This County does not operate residential alcohol and drug treatment facilities and therefore contracts for such services.

Your Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board is aware of the fact that there is a need for residential treatment for those individuals who cannot stay clean and sober through utilization of groups offered in the recovery community, traditional services and Heritage House. Behavioral Health and Recovery Services has sent one person to Comprehensive Addiction Programs over the last 12 months.

The current agreement with this contractor was approved by County Counsel and your Board on July 13, 2006 by Resolution Number 06-317.

Financial

This contract will continue to be paid within the Alcohol and Drug budget unit 0403. The costs remain at: \$2,500 per client per 30 day stay; \$250.00 per client per 3 day detoxification program. Only the individuals who are committed to their own recovery, and who need a high level of care, will be offered this level of service. There is no impact on the general fund.
