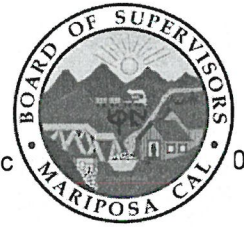

RE: Clarity Social Research Agreement to provide evaluation services for the Drug Court program

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve an Agreement with Clarity Social Research to Provide Evaluation Services for the Expanded Drug Court Program Conducted by Mariposa County Behavioral Health in an Amount Not to Exceed \$22,000, and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Agreement.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board approved the existing contract on December 3, 2013 by Resolution 2013-540.

On July 31, 2013, the Human Services Department was awarded a grant for a "Drug Court Enhancement Project" to expand substance abuse treatment services. The grant amount for 2014-15 is \$239,007. This contract is part of the expansion of services outlined in the "Mariposa County Drug Court Enhancement Project."

The Board approved submission of the grant application on April 16, 2013, by Resolution 2013-142. The grant award was accepted by the Board on October 8, 2013.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

This contract is part of the activities planned to comply with the grant. If this contract is not approved, Mariposa County Behavioral Health may not be able to comply with the grant terms, which may jeopardize funding for this and subsequent years.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This contract will be paid with funds awarded by a federal grant for the "Mariposa County Drug Court Enhancement Project."

The grant funds and associated contracts are incorporated in the Alcohol & Drug budget unit 001-0403. There is no impact to the County general fund.
