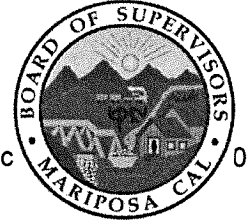

## RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2014-327

MEETING: July 8, 2014

TO: The Board of Supervisors

RE: Agreement with the Counseling & Psychotherapy Center to Perform Court Ordered Services

### RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve an Agreement with the Counseling & Psychotherapy Center to Perform Court Ordered Services in an Amount Not to Exceed \$14,000, and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Agreement.

The Counseling & Psychotherapy Center (CPC) will perform court ordered services for referred juvenile offenders as listed below.

Each item is per person rate.

1. Risk Evaluation	\$1,200
2. Intake Treatment Assessment	\$ 250
3. 52 Weeks of individual sessions @ \$85.00 per session	\$4,420
4. Polygraph Examinations	
a. Sexual History and Index Offense/Single Issue	\$ 400
b. Maintenance & Monitoring	\$ 350

The services are to be rendered at 1760 U Street, Merced, California 95340.

These services are not offered by the department and CPC has asked that the services be done under contract. The juveniles in question are currently under court order to receive intense treatment for sex offenders and the specialty services requested will target a vital part of their treatment and recovery. CPC has been working with convicted juvenile and adult sex offenders for over 30 years, and has developed a community based sexual assault treatment and management program of the highest quality. Treatment for this type of high risk sex offender takes a year of intense one-on-one specialty services. CPC works with the offender to identify their specific behavioral triggers while working with them on a relapse prevention plan that will prevent further victimization.

The juveniles are currently enrolled in the Wraparound program, and the cost of this agreement is funded in the 2014-2015 Wraparound budget. There will be no impact to the General Fund.

### BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The existing Agreement with the Counseling & Psychotherapy Center was approved by the Board on March 4, 2014 by Resolution 2014-89.

**ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:**

If these services are not rendered we may be in violation of a court order.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**


**This agreement is funded in the 2014-2015 requested budget for the Wraparound program. There is no impact to the County General Fund.**
