WHEREAS, LINN started picking up trash from his road to Highway 49 long before it was popular to do; and






WHEREAS, BERNIE started weekly Senior Men's Breakfast Club at the Senior Center; and




WHEREAS, BILL helped with Yosemite Association book sales and pitched in during emergencies, i.e. severe winter storms, the flood of 1997; and


WHEREAS, BILL freely shares his extensive knowledge and obvious love and respect for Yosemite and is "The penultimate example of volunteer spirit."
