Resolution Authorizing the Public Works Director and County Counsel to Apply for and Execute State Matching Grant for FAA Airport Improvement from the State of California - Department of Transportation Aeronautics.

Grant funds will be used to pay \$122,400 (4.5%) on a grant agreement in the amount of \$2,720,000 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On November 20, 1998 the Board approved the pre-application for federal assistance in the amount of \$2,720,000.

On March 23, 1999, per Resolution No. 99-94, the Board approved execution of the grant agreement with the FAA.

No action. The County would pay the full 10% of the \$2,720,000 grant from the FAA with no assistance from the California Department of Transportation.



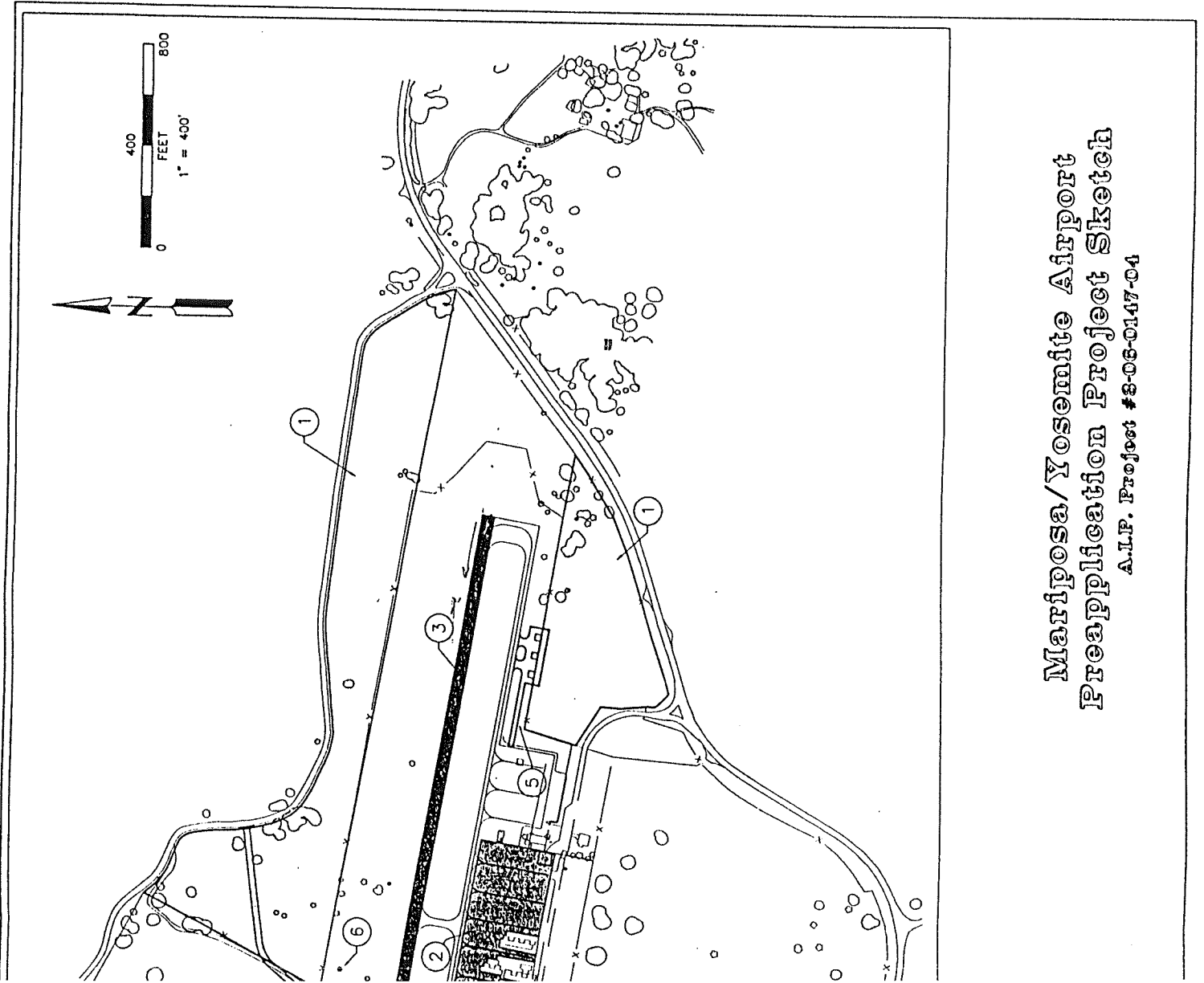


