WHEREAS, FORREST worked a double 11-44 accident with out of County follow-up which is today still remembered by his Supervisor with admiration; and

WHEREAS, FORREST was the Officer who discovered that the Mustangs did not work well in the snow and was the Mariposa snow chain expert, always ready to assist fellow Officers and was well liked by the auto tech, who always gave him the newer cars; and

WHEREAS, FORREST served as the Bus Officer and Weapons Officer; and


WHEREAS, FORREST has been married to his wife Judy for 30 years who said he is the most honorable man she has ever met; and




WHEREAS, FORREST has enjoyed his hobby of golf and has purchased a new motor home for his retirement.




