NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sheriff of the County of Mariposa is hereby authorized, on its behalf, to submit the attached proposal to O.C.J.P. and is further authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors the attached Grant Award Agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the applicant agrees to provide all matching funds required for said project (including any amendment thereof) under the program and the funding terms and conditions of O.C.J.P. and that the cash match will be appropriate as required, subject to appropriation by the Board of Supervisors.

IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and O.C.J.P. disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

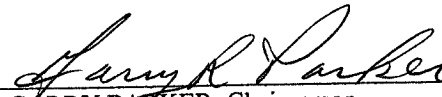
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received here under shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

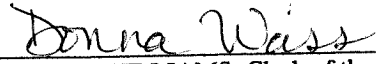

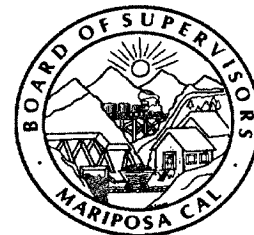
