**WHEREAS**, the month of May is "Older American's Month", and Mariposa County wishes to honor an outstanding senior volunteer; and


**WHEREAS**, IRENE RHYNE has resided in Mariposa County for twenty years and has rendered many hours to community service programs as a volunteer over these years; and


**WHEREAS**, IRENE enjoys sewing, quilting and embroidery and is currently involved in a fundraising quilt project for the history center.
