RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION: (Policy Item: Yes ___ No X)

Public Works request a resolution declaring Old Engine 233 from Fish Camp as salvage, and releasing it to Burton's Fire Apparatus in payemnt for towing and storage expense. This fire engine was involved in a roll-over accident causing extensive damage. The insurance company has since totalled the vehicle and has settled the claim. The engine is still at Burton's and is of no value to the County. Burton's is willing to take the engine for salvage in lieu of payment for towing and storage. Staff feels that this is in the best interest to the County.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

Board has previously declared vehicles as surplus and salvage and disposed of accordingly.

LIST ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

No action-County would have to have vehicle towed back to Mariposa, pay tow bill of \$660.00 and then scrap the unit.

Burton's Fire Apparatus had the Fish Camp mini squad pumper towed to our repair shop last year per Allen Browns request from the insurance company. This unit has been at our facility for approximately six months.


It is my understanding that the repairs will **not** be made on this unit, it has been totaled out. Fish Camp Fire has removed several items from the unit, winch, lights, aluminum diamond plate compartment, radios, siren speakers, siren control heads and many more items. The fire department is welcome to any of the warning lights that are still good.

Burton's Fire Apparatus has a tow bill for \$330.00 that no one has been invoiced for. It would cost the **same** to have the unit towed back to Mariposa County. Now we have a cost of \$660.00 approximately.

Burton's Fire Apparatus would be willing to take unit for salvage instead of payment for the money due.
