
WHEREAS, the County of Mariposa further commits resources to ensure the success of the Red Ribbon Celebration and year round alcohol and other drug prevention efforts.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors encourages all community members to pledge:


NO USE OF ILLEGAL DRUGS, AND NO ILLEGAL USE OF LEGAL DRUGS


