RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve the 90-Day Findings Quality Improvement Plan for the Mariposa County Head Start Program and authorize the Chairman to sign a letter submitting the plan to the United States Department of Health and Human Services. The Madera County Community Action Agency and the Mariposa County Head Start Parent Policy Council developed the 90-Day Findings Quality Improvement Plan in response to the on-site program review conducted by the Administration for Children and Families. The on-site program review determined that the Mariposa County Head Start Program had several areas of deficiencies that must be corrected within 90-days for health and safety reasons, and that by law must be addressed in a Quality Improvement Plan in order to continue to receive federal funding.

The 90-Day Findings Quality Improvement Plan specifies each deficiency and the corrective action that is being taken to correct the deficiency.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The former County Administrative Officer acting with the authority granted by the Board of Supervisors approved and submitted the 90-Day Findings Quality Improvement Plan developed in September 1997 by the Madera County Community Action Agency.

LIST ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve the 90-Day Findings Quality Improvement Plan. The Mariposa County Head Start Program will be in non-compliance and will not receive federal funding.
