

**RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

Review and approve the 2001 Mariposa County Legislative/Regulatory Platform.

The platform serves as our overall guide for advocacy in Sacramento for the 2001 calendar year. County staff worked with Supervisor Pickard to develop the proposals in the draft platform with the assistance of Dale Wagerman Associates. In addition to stating General Goals and Priorities, the draft platform includes several specific areas of focus including:

- Work with the legislative delegation to include funding for Phase III of the Mariposa Creek Parkway project in the 2001-2002 state budget.
- Support legislation increasing state funding for local roads.
- Advocate for funding to assist with the review of the General Plan based upon the anticipated impacts of the proposed University California campus near Merced and ensure the County's ability to evaluate any actions associated with La Paloma Road.
- Support/sponsor legislation that will implement a process to account for State Transportation Improvement Program funds that are allocated to the County.
- Secure State financial assistance for the County's co-composting project.

**BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:**

The Board has adopted a Legislative/Regulatory Platform for the past several years.
