MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 985

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2.16.010 AND 2.16.040 OF CHAPTER 2.16 ENTITLED "PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR AND PUBLIC CONSERVATOR/PUBLIC GUARDIAN" OF THE MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors received a request from the Treasurer/Tax Collector and the Sheriff/Coroner to transfer the Public Administrator duties from the Treasurer/Tax Collector to the Sheriff/Coroner, and

WHEREAS, all parties agree that the Public Administrator function can be better served by the Sheriff/Coroner who has the necessary resources to perform this function,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Amend the following Sections of Chapter 2.16 of the Mariposa County Code:

2.16.010 Designated.

Pursuant to Probate Code sections 7600 et seq., the Sheriff/Coroner of the County is designated as the Public Administrator. Pursuant to California Probate Code sections 2900 et seq., the Director of Human Services is designated as the Public Guardian and Public Conservator of the County.


2.16.040 Compensation.

The Public Conservator and Public Guardian shall receive as total compensation for his/her services an annual salary as designated by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors as Director of Human Services of the County. The Public Administrator shall receive a total compensation for his/her services an annual salary as designated by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors as Sheriff/Coroner of the County.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final passage pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 25123.
