# MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 971

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.44.020 ENTITLED "MEMBERSHIP" TO CHAPTER 2.44 ENTITLED "BOARD OF LAW LIBRARY TRUSTEES" OF THE MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa does ordain as follows:

**SECTION I:** Section 2.44.020 of Chapter 2.44 of the Mariposa County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 2.44.020 Membership.

The Mariposa County Board of Law Library Trustees is constituted as follows:

- A. Both Judges of the Superior Court are to serve as ex officio trustees;
- B. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors is an ex officio trustee, but the Board of Supervisors at the request of the Chair may appoint a member of the State Bar, any other member of the Board of Supervisors, or a resident of the county to serve as trustee in place of the Chair;
- C. The District Attorney;
- D. County Counsel; and
- E. President of the Local Bar Association

**SECTION II:** This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final passage pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 25123.
