

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 719

AMENDING CHAPTER 12.16
ENTITLED "RECREATIONAL AREAS" BY
RESCINDING AND REPLACING
SECTION 12.16.110 IN ITS ENTIRETY

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARIPOSA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of California, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Chapter 12.16 of the Mariposa County Code entitled "Recreational Areas" shall be amended by rescinding and replacing Section 12.16.110 entitled "Recreational Use of Bureau of Land Management Section of Merced River Area South of Briceburg", to read in its entirety as follows:

"12.16.110 Recreational Use of Bureau of Land Management and National Forest Sections of the Merced River Area Downstream of Briceburg.

A. No person shall camp or park any vehicle overnight upon the roadbed, and/or shoulders of the road, or pullouts which are posted "no parking" along:

i. The Merced River access roads between Briceburg, California, Mariposa County, and McCabe Flats Campground on lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management.

ii. On the upslope side of the Merced River access road between Moss Creek downstream to the National Forest boundary line as posted by the National Forest Service.

B. No person shall camp or stay overnight on the upslope side of the Merced River access road, downstream from Briceburg, on lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management, except in a campground designated by the Bureau of Land Management.

C. No person shall take possession of, occupy or otherwise use the area from Moss Creek downstream to the National Forest boundary line as posted by the National Forest Service adjacent to the Merced River for residential purposes without a special-use authorization, or otherwise authorized by Federal law of regulation. For purposes of this paragraph "residential purposes" shall mean to make one's home by living or residing on National Forest land. Any person who is gainfully employed and is residing on National Forest land is in violation of this section.

D. No person shall discharge a firearm or ignite any type of fireworks within one-half (1/2) mile of the center of the Merced River on lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management or the National Forest Service.

E. Camping is limited to fourteen (14) days within any ninety (90) day period on Bureau of Land Management lands open to camping.

F. Camping is limited to fourteen (14) days in any calendar year on National Forest Land."

SECTION II: This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of final passage, pursuant to Government Code Section 25123.


