

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 547

2 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 18.02.060 OF THE MARIPOSA COUNTY
3 CODE TO PROVIDE A PROCESS FOR PROVING VESTED RIGHTS TO CONDUCT
4 SURFACE MINING OPERATIONS.

5 The Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political
6 subdivision of the State of California, does hereby ordain and
7 establish as follows:

8 SECTION I: Section 18.02.060 of the Mariposa County Code is
9 hereby amended to read as follows:

10 18.02.060 Recognition of vested rights in existing operation.

11 The procedures for obtaining recognition of vested rights to
12 conduct surface mining operations shall be as follows:

13 A. All persons presently conducting or having obtained
14 vested rights to conduct surface mining operations shall submit
15 a notification that shall be presented to the planning office by
16 September 1, 1979, and will include the following information:

17 1. Names and addresses of the operator and any
18 persons designated as the operator's agents for the service of
19 process;

20 2. The size and legal description of the lands that
21 are affected by such operation and a map that includes the bound-
22 aries and topographical details of such lands.

23 B. In the event that the notification provided for in
24 Subdivision A was not submitted on or before September 1, 1979,
25 all persons presently conducting or claiming to have obtained
26 vested rights to conduct surface mining operations may obtain
27 recognition of vested rights if it is established at a public hearing
28 before the county planning commission that such rights have been
perfected.

1 SECTION II: This ordinance shall become effective thirty days
2 from the date of passage pursuant to Government Code Section
3 25123.
