

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 435

1  
2           The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa do  
3 hereby ordain as follows:

4           SECTION 1:

5           There is hereby created the building department of the  
6 County of Mariposa. This department shall consist of the Building  
7 Inspector and such other officers and employees as may be provided  
8 for by the Board of Supervisors.

9           SECTION 2:

10           The Building Department agrees to enforce within the  
11 boundaries of the County of Mariposa all the applicable county  
12 ordinances relating to the State's and County's statutory responsi-  
13 bilities under all of the provisions of the State Housing Law and  
14 Earthquake Protection Law, Division 13, Parts 1.5 and 3, and  
15 Sections 18300 and 19992 of the Health and Safety Code of the State  
16 of California as applicable; California Administrative Code, Title  
17 25, Chapters 1, 3, and 5 as applicable and all other applicable  
18 provisions of County Ordinance No. 289, and all future ordinances  
19 and laws and amendments thereto relating to building. Such enforce-  
20 ment shall include all of the duties prescribed by these laws, rules  
21 and regulations including the making of all inspections and issuance  
22 of permits and orders required in enforcement.

23           SECTION 3:

24           The Building Inspector shall be the zoning enforcement  
25 officer of the County of Mariposa and shall see to the enforcement  
26 of the zoning ordinance.

27           SECTION 4:

28           The building department shall collect all fees as


1 required by law. The fees charged shall be those required by State  
2 law or by County ordinance, whichever is applicable. For the  
3 Earthquake Protection law the fees will be those established by the  
4 Commission of Housing and Community Development unless and until  
5 the county sets such fees, in which case the county fees shall be  
6 applicable. The fees collected for the administration of the  
7 Mobilehome Parks Act within Mobilehome Parks shall become the  
8 property of the State. All other fees collected shall become the  
9 property of the County of Mariposa.

10 SECTION 5:


11 This ordinance shall become effective April 1, 1977.
