

ORDINANCE NO. 250

1 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa do
2 ordain as follows:

3 SECTION 1. Sub-section (b) of section 1 of Mariposa
4 County Ordinance number 227 is hereby repealed, and a new sub-
5 section (b) of section 1 of said ordinance number 227 is enacted
6 as follows:


7 " (b) On 6th Street between Charles Street and the
8 Mariposa Creek bridge, parking on the north
9 side thereof is prohibited; parallel parking
10 only is permitted on the south side thereof
11 between Mariposa Creek bridge and a line parallel
12 with and situate 69 feet west of the westerly
13 line of Charles Street (State Sign Route 140);
14 a loading zone, to be used by commercial vehicles
15 only while loading or unloading merchandise and
16 while parked parallel with the southerly line of
17 6th Street as close thereto as reasonably possible,
18 is hereby established on the south side of 6th
19 Street between the westerly line of Charles Street
20 (State Sign Route 140) and a line 69 feet west of
21 and parallel with said westerly line of Charles
22 Street. "

23 SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors have found, and
24 do hereby find, that 6th Street is the only improved street con-
25 necting the areas on either side of Mariposa Creek in the town
26 of Mariposa; that 6th Street between Charles Street and the
27 Mariposa Creek bridge is heavily travelled and carries two-way
28 traffic at times when two-way traffic upon Charles Street is also
29 heavy; that since September, 1962, a parking lot has been con-
30 structed adjacent to the north line of 6th Street west of Charles
31 Street, thereby increasing traffic congestion in that area; that
32 the diagonal and other parking of vehicles upon the south side of
6th Street between Charles Street and Mariposa Creek constitutes
a traffic hazard and seriously endangers persons and property;
that it is necessary, in the interests of health and safety, that
the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance be effective forth-
with. For the foregoing reasons this ordinance shall take effect
immediately as an emergency measure. A true copy hereof shall be
published once in the Mariposa Gazette within 15 days after date.
