ORDINANCE NO. 274

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 8 of County Ordinance number 174 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. Employees, except those classified as exempt in Section 4 and elective and appointive officials listed in Section 10 and Road Department employees mentioned in Section 9.5, shall be paid monthly according to the following 5-step salary range classification plan, with each employee entering employment at the first step of the salary range classification provided for his or her employment, or such step thereof as the Board of Supervisors shall by minute order designate at the time of hiring, to wit:

1 SECTION III. Sub-sections J, K, and L, of Section 10 of Ordinance  
2 No. 174 are hereby repealed. Sub-sections F, G, H, and I, of said  
3 section 10 are amended to read as follows, and a new sub-section  
4 J of said section 10 is enacted as follows:

- 5 "F. The Judge of the Mariposa Judicial District Court shall  
6 receive a salary of \$6,480.00 per annum.
- 7 G. The Judge of the Coulterville Judicial District Court  
8 shall receive a salary of \$1,620.00 per annum.
- 9 H. The Constable of Mariposa Judicial District shall receive  
10 a salary of \$4,608.00 per annum.
- 11 I. The Constable of the Coulterville Judicial District shall  
12 receive a salary of \$3,240.00 per annum.
- 13 J. The Director of Recreation and Parks shall receive a  
14 salary of \$6,300.00 per annum."

15 SECTION IV. Each employee shall be assigned a step classification  
16 within the applicable salary range provided for that employment by  
17 sections 9 and 10 which will result in payment of the same amount  
18 of salary received by such employee immediately prior to the  
19 effective date of this ordinance, except that, where a change of  
20 classification, or prior action of the Board of Supervisors, will  
21 result, or is intended to result, in an increase or decrease in  
22 a rate of compensation, the Board of Supervisors shall make an  
23 order on its minutes prior to the effective date of this ordinance  
24 particularly assigning each such step within an applicable salary  
25 range as shall be necessary in order to effect each such increase  
26 or decrease in compensation. The anniversary date of any officer  
27 or employee whose compensation is increased by the express terms  
28 of this ordinance, shall be the effective date of this ordinance.

29 SECTION V. This ordinance shall take effect and be operative on  
30 and after September 1, 1966.


