

ORDINANCE NO. 294

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa do ordain as follows:


SECTION I. A new subsection "K" of Section 10 of Ordinance No. 174 is enacted as follows:

"K. The County Sealer of Weights and Measures shall receive the sum of \$3.90 per hour for each hour spent by him in the performance of his official duties."


SECTION II. The Board finds that the legislature has enacted Assembly Bill #619 which abolishes the position of Deputy State Sealer of Weights and Measures and that said law will become effective as of 12:01 a.m., November 8, 1967; that when said law goes into effect, Mariposa County will not have a sealer of weights and measures; that public health, safety, and welfare require that the County of Mariposa continue to have the services of a sealer of weights and measures. For the foregoing reasons, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment as an urgency measure for the immediate protection of the public health, safety, and welfare, within the meaning of Subsection "D" of Government Code Section 25123 and the Constitution of the State of California.
