ORDINANCE NO. 296


The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. Effective thirty (30) days after date hereof, it shall be unlawful for the owner, possessor, or driver of any motor vehicle weighing in excess of fifteen (15) tons/gross laden weight, to permit or cause the same to travel that portion of Harris Cutoff Road from the junction of Harris Cutoff Road and Chowchilla Mt. Road to the junction of Harris Cutoff Road and Harris Road in the County of Mariposa.


SECTION II. Every violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or imprisonment in the Mariposa County Jail for a period not to exceed six (6) months or by both said fine and imprisonment.
