

1 is ready for destruction or has been collected or stored for
2 salvage or conversion to some use. Any article or material which,
3 unaltered, or unchanged, and without further reconditioning can
4 be used for its purpose readily as or when new, shall not be
5 considered junk.

6 B) The terms "dump" and "disposal area" shall mean a
7 public or private "disposal area" as defined in Mariposa County
8 Ordinance No. 259 and shall also mean a place or places used
9 for the disposal of materials by methods including, but not
10 limited to, the following: disposal, incineration, or reduction.
11 "Materials" include "garbage" and "refuse" as those terms are
12 defined in Ordinance No. 259.

13 C) "Use Permit" means a written authorization issued by
14 the Planning Commission or other agency, officer, or employee
15 of the County of Mariposa, that the Board may designate, author-
16 izing the permittee to carry on a land use subject to the pro-
17 visions of Section 2 of this Ordinance.

18 SECTION 4: The provisions of this Ordinance shall not
19 affect land use commenced prior to the effective date hereof.

20 SECTION 5: Use permits may be revocable, conditional, or
21 valid for a term period, and may be issued only for use or pur-
22 poses for which permits are required or permitted by the terms
23 of this Ordinance and shall be governed by the following reg-
24 ulations:

25 A) Application for use permit shall be made to the
26 Planning Commission in writing on a form prescribed by the
27 Commission and shall be accompanied by plans and elevations
28 where necessary, and shall adequately describe the proposed
29 use. Such application shall be accompanied by a fee of ten
30 (10) dollars, no part of which shall be returnable to the
31 applicant.

32 B) The Planning Commission may hold such hearings

1 thereon as it may deem necessary.

2 C) The Planning Commission shall find that the establish-
3 ing or operation of the use applied for will or will not, under
4 the circumstances of the particular case, be detrimental to
5 public health, safety, and welfare, or contrary to provisions
6 of the County Master Plan or General Plan. The Planning Commission
7 may designate such conditions as it deems necessary to carry out
8 the purpose of this Ordinance, General or Master Plan, and may
9 require appropriate guarantees that such conditions will be
10 complied with.

11 SECTION 6: Any applicant, or other interest/^{ed}party, not
12 satisfied with the action of the Planning Commission may, within
13 ten (10) days after the formal decision of the Planning Commission,
14 appeal in writing to the Board of Supervisors. A copy of such
15 appeal shall be submitted to the Commission. Said Board shall
16 render its' decision within ~~sixty-five~~ (65) days after the filing of
17 such appeal. Appellant shall have the right of hearing before
18 the Board.

19 SECTION 7: Any use permit may be revoked in any case
20 where the conditions of such permit are not being complied with.
21 The Planning Commission shall give ~~ten--(10)-----~~ written notice
22 of intention to revoke such permit to the permittee at least ten
23 (10) days prior to a hearing thereof. Any revocation shall be
24 appealable in the same manner as the denial of a permit as above
25 specified. In any case where the use specified in the use permit
26 has not been commenced within six (6) months after the date of
27 such permit, then, without further action by the Commission, or
28 the Board, the use permit granted shall be null and void.

29 SECTION 8: A County Master Plan or General Plan has been
30 adopted. The Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors
31 have conducted in good faith, and are conducting in good faith,
32 studies for the purpose of adopting a Countywide comprehensive

1 zoning regulations and specific plans consistent with a Master
2 or General Plan.

3 SECTION 9: Penalties for violation

4 Any person, firm, or corporation, whether as principal,
5 agent, employee, or otherwise, violating any of the provisions
6 of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
7 conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine of not more
8 than \$300.00, by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term
9 not to exceed three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprison-
10 ment.

11 SECTION 10:

11 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa hereby
12 find that it is necessary for this Ordinance to take effect
13 immediately upon its passage as an urgency measure in the in-
14 terest of public safety, health, and welfare. For the foregoing
15 reasons, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its
16 passage, as an urgency measure, in accordance with the provisions
17 of Government Code Section 65858, and other applicable laws and
18 Constitutional provisions.




