ORDINANCE NO. 144

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa,  
State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. No person shall stop, park or leave standing  
any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, in any of the  
following places:

- (a) Within fifteen feet of the entrance to any  
theatre.
- (b) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped,  
parked or standing at the curb or edge of a  
Highway.
- (c) On Charles Street in the Town of Mariposa,  
within fifteen feet either side of a point one  
hundred and thirty-five feet southerly from the  
curbs at the corner of Sixth and Charles Streets,  
except for the purpose of loading or unloading  
freight. This limitation shall apply only be-  
tween the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., and does  
not apply on Sundays or holidays.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of  
this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon  
conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than  
\$50.00.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 116, passed June 5, 1939, and  
Ordinance No. 137 are hereby repealed.
