**RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

Adopt a resolution approving the road name "Tenaya Trail" for the subject easement, and approving the road name change for a portion of Mariposa Creek Circle.(See Map) The road name is consistent with the road naming requirements of County Resolution No. 92-541, and all the property owners served by this easement approve the road name request and road name change. Additionally, the rename request will eliminate confusion regarding the location of Mariposa Creek Circle (the road "forks" and both "forks" are name the same name.

The applicants propose Tenaya Trail after Chief Tenaya, a Native American chief who lived in Mariposa County in the 1800's. Chief Tenaya was the son of an Ahwahneechee Tribe Leader and is associated with Mariposa's gold rush area.

**BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:**

The applicants are naming the new easement in conjunction with Land Division Application No. 1437. The portion of existing easement to be renamed was created by parcel map in 1972.

The Board adopted Resolution No. 92-541 in 1992 establishing criteria for naming non-County roads. Generally, road names shall be developed around some historical, botanical, zoological or geological significance as it directly relates to Mariposa County. All property owners served by the road must be notified, and a majority of the property owners must approve of the road name request.

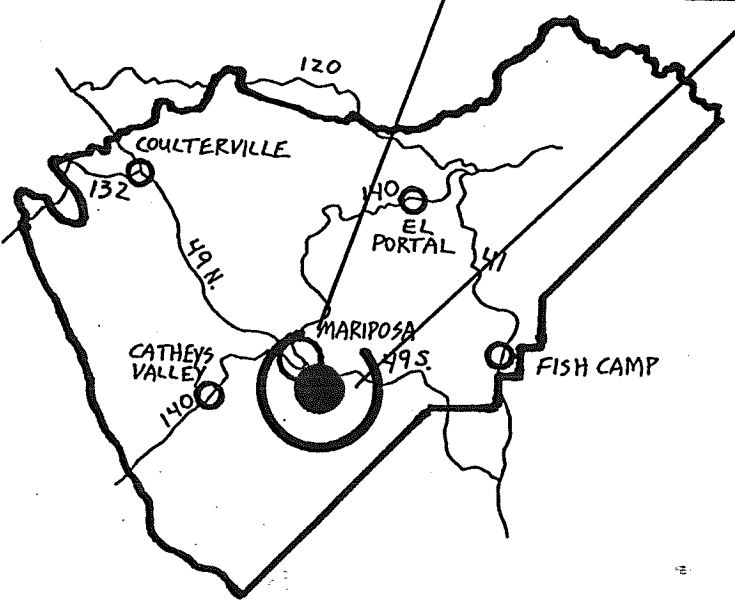
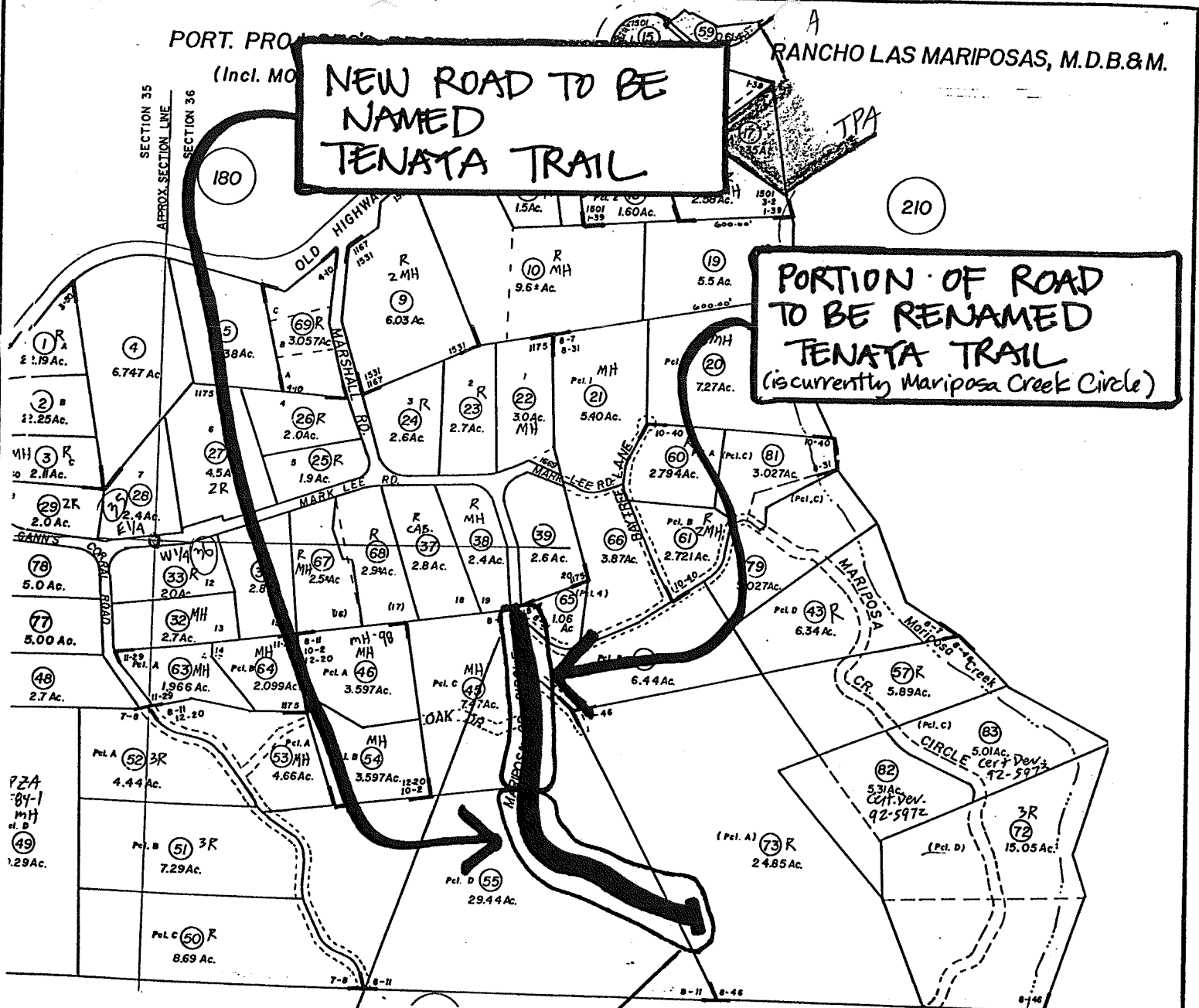
