**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING RICHARD SHELTON FOR HIS EFFORTS TO IMPROVE

WHEREAS, RICHARD SHELTON has demonstrated a significant interest in fire protection for Catheys Valley; and

WHEREAS, RICHARD identified and located a fire engine scheduled for surplus from the Department of Energy and the Palo Alto Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, RICHARD contacted federal property office to arrange for transfer of the engine to the custody of Mariposa County; and


WHEREAS, RICHARD continued to act on behalf of the Mariposa County Fire Department during a prolonged waiting period; and
