RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION: (Policy Item: Yes No_X)

Adopt the attached Resolution which amends the previous Resolution adopted by the Board by revising Mario Diaz's disability retirement date from January 1, 1998 to February 1, 1998. PERS recently informed Mr. Diaz that because they did not receive his application for retirement until February 13, 1998, the effective date of retirement can be no earlier than February 1, 1998 in accordance with Government Code section 21252. Government Code section 21252 states:

"In no event shall the retirement date become effective or the retirement allowance begin to accrue earlier than the first of the month in which the member's application is received at an office of the board or by an employee of the system designated by the board."

This amended Resolution also includes a revision to the advanced disability pension payment section by <u>not</u> advancing disability payments. Mr. Diaz recently began receiving "Service Retirement" benefits while awaiting approval of his application for "Service Pending Industrial Disability Retirement"; an individual that files a "Service Pending Industrial Disability Retirement" application receives slightly more benefits than a straight "Service Retirement". After the adoption of the attached Resolution and upon receipt by PERS of the Resolution, PERS will forward to Mr. Diaz his remaining benefits.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board adopted Resolution No. 98-212 on June 9, 1998 certifying Mario Diaz's disability retirement effective January 1, 1998.

RESOLUTION NO. 98-273 (Amends Resolution No. 98-212)

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF MARIPOSA

Section 21156, Government Code

WHEREAS, the County of Mariposa (hereinafter referred to as Agency) is a contracting agency of the Public Employees' Retirement System;

WHEREAS, an application for disability retirement of Mario Diaz employed by the Agency in the position of Jail Officer has been filed with the Public Employees' Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the County of Mariposa has reviewed the medical and other evidence relevant to such alleged disability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Mariposa find and determine and it does hereby find and determine that Mario Diaz is incapacitated within the meaning of the Public Employees' Retirement Law for performance of his duties in the position of Jail Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A PETITION has been filed with the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board for a determination pursuant to Section 21166, Government Code; and a copy of such determination will be provided when rendered; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the member was separated from his employment in the position of Jail Officer after expiration of his leave rights under Section 21164, Government Code, effective December 13, 1997 and that no dispute as to the expiration of such leave rights is pending.

There is not a possibility of third party liability.

Advanced Disability Pension payments will not be made.

The primary disabling condition is injury to right knee, right hip, and left elbow from a slip and fall.

The member's disabling condition is not a direct consequence of a violent act perpetrated upon the member's person.

The effective date of the member's disability retirement is February 1, 1998.
