PUBLIC HEARING:

Following a Public Hearing, Public Works recommends that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached Resolution of Vacation of a portion of Eleventh Street in the town of Mariposa.

The portion of Eleventh Street proposed to be vacated is to become part of the parking area for the new County Administrative Offices. The construction of the parking area, already underway, has and will continue to block Eleventh Street in such a manner that it will no longer connect between Bullion Strteet and Jones Street.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On August 19 of this year, the Board adopted a Resolution of Intention to vacate this portion of Eleventh Street. Notice of this hearing has been published in the newspaper and posted along Eleventh Street in the area being proposed for vacation.

LIST ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this resolution is not adopted, Eleventh Street in the area of the proposed parking lot will continue to be a road within the County Maintained Road System.

RESOLUTION 97- 373

WHEREAS, On August 19, 1997 the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County declared its intention to vacate a portion of Eleventh Street in the Town of Mariposa as described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the westerly line of Jones Street with the northerly line of Eleventh Street; thence along the northerly line of Eleventh Street south 53° 56' west 117.5 feet; thence leaving said northerly line, south 36° 04' east, 50.00 feet to a point on the southerly line of Eleventh Street; thence north 53° 56' east along the southerly line of eleventh Street, 117.5 feet to the westerly line of Jones Street; thence north 36° 04' west along the westerly line of Jones Street, 50.00 feet to the point of beginning.


and set September 16, 1997 at 9:30 A.M. as the date and time for a public hearing thereon, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has found that the above described portion of Eleventh Street is not necessary for County Road or Town Street purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the authority granted by Section 8324 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County hereby vacate the above described portion of Eleventh Street in the Town of Mariposa.


