RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

(Policy Item: Yes \_\_\_ No X)

Resolution approving application to the Bureau of Land Management to participate in a four-year program to identify, access, improve and purchase a 19.01 acre quartz onyx claim for the purpose of expanding Catheys Valley County Park. This action is under guidelines set forth in the U.S. Recreation and Public Purposes Act. It is further requested that the Director of Public Works be designated to sign and execute all documents.

BLM's 19.01 acre onyx/quartz claim in western Mariposa County, is within a few feet of being adjacent to Mariposa County's Catheys Valley Park. Catheys Valley Park is a 5 acre site featuring a 2,000 square foot Community Hall, a County firehouse of similar size, a baseball field, picnic area, outdoor rest rooms, and an 1875 school house that is being restored.

It is Mariposa County's intention to enter into a lease agreement with BLM, acquire an easement through one of the two adjoining properties, survey and fence the parcel, mitigate the mining excavations, and construct a nature trail that will show the best features of the property.

In keeping with the Mariposa County Parks Master Plan, adopted by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors in 1992 the western Mariposa County area will be deficient 19.2 acres in park lands by the 2005. The annexation of the 19.01 acres will allow the County to maintain the adopted level of park land to 1 acre per thousand population.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

During the FY 97/98 budget hearings, the Board approved the total amount (\$14,200) of the estimated cost to acquire and improve the parcel to an acceptable level over a four-year period.
