RESOLUTION NO. 87-69

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR ANNUAL  
INSPECTIONS OF AND REPORTS ON COUNTY BUILDINGS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the Safety Officer shall inspect the County Buildings annually; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Safety Officer shall issue a written report immediately after each inspection, with copies distributed to County Counsel, the Director of Maintenance and the Department head of all affected Departments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Maintenance Director will have a maximum of 40 days to correct all deficiencies listed in the report. However, should a specific hazard be deemed an immediate danger to employees or the public, it will be so indicated in the report and corrective measures will be required immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED after the above time period, the Safety Officer shall do a follow-up inspection for compliance with his recommendations. The Safety Officer shall then notify the Facilities Committee of the Board of Supervisors of the status of facilities out of compliance with his recommendations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if additional funding will be required to remove a hazard or instruction is needed from the Board of Supervisors they will be notified at the time of the follow-up inspection.



**SAFETY OFFICER  
POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR ANNUAL INSPECTIONS AND REPORTS**

County facilities will be inspected on an annual schedule. Upon completion of the inspections the Safety Officer shall issue a written report. Copies of the written reports will be distributed to County Counsel, Director of the Maintenance Department responsible for the facility and to the Department Head, whose department is affected.

The Maintenance Department Director will have 40 days maximum to correct all deficiencies listed in the report. However, should a specific hazard be deemed an immediate danger to employees or the public, it will be so indicated in the report and corrective measures will be required immediately.

After the above time period, the Safety Officer shall do a follow-up inspection for compliance with his recommendations. The Safety Officer shall then notify the Facilities Committee of the Board of Supervisors of the status of facilities out of compliance with his recommendations.

If additional funding will be required to remove a hazard or instruction is needed from the Board of Supervisors they will be notified at that time.
